Student Use of the Internet Policies

St. Joseph Parish PSR

1. Student use of the parish computers and the Internet on parish property both on site and through remote connections is governed by the policies of the Diocese of Youngstown and this PSR Family Handbook.
2. The use of the Internet and computer lab is a privilege and may be revoked by the PDRE, the Computer Lab Catechist or the Classroom Catechist at any time for violation of any policies and/or inappropriate behavior in the lab.
3. All telecommunications access on the parish computers is limited to parish-obtained sites, and is restricted to PSR-related projects only.
4. Personal accounts may not be accessed at St. Joseph Parish.
5. Students must be supervised at all times.
6. An Internet Computer Access Form must be signed by the students and parents before students can use the lab. This form will be kept in the PSR office and is available in the Appendixes of the PSR Family Handbook.
7. Computers, including all information, programs, software, and use privileges belong solely to the parish and are subject to review and inspection at any time.
8. Each student will be assigned to a specific computer and will use the computer during each lab class.
9. Student behavior codes that will have consequences, which could lead to no computer privileges:
 - Misconduct including the transmission of unauthorized information.
 - Damage or destruction of parish property or property contained on parish property.
 - Forgery including hacking into unauthorized computers, sites, or information databases.
 - Attempting to access restricted anything.
 - Failure to cooperate with the agreement regulations, computer lab catechist, or any other PSR staff persons.
10. Consequences for inappropriate computer use:
 - Student's computer privileges may be revoked for the remainder of the PSR year.
 - Notification of parent/s.

The computer lab and its contents are a great tool for learning. We expect every student to use it for this purpose, and to enjoy this experience.
